- Added Light Table for image comparison (PRO Edition only)
- Focus Points display optionally has an enlarged pop-out window to ease selection.

- Improved histogram to display color histograms simultaneously.
- Improved accuracy of histogram display.
- Improved camera detection on logic on Mac computers.
- Improved disconnect detection on Mac Sierra.
- Added Automatic reconnection of camera following a disconnect on Mac computers.
- Added image capture using double click to image viewer windows.
- Added option to set the number of days to retain unsaved images.
- Changed the JPG and NEF path fields on the File Save Options Panel to be display only and require the use of the Folder Selector instead to minimize possible bad path entry.

## **Bugs Fixed**

- Fixed crash with D40/D5000 when white balance is set to Use Photo.
- Corrected problem with vertical images not always correctly rotating when switching between thumbnail images.
- Fixed issues where unsaved images were deleted when program was restarted following a program crash.
- Improved error handling when invalid save paths are specified.
- Fixed error when moving focus point in Live View Movie Mode on D500 when in 4K UHD frame size.
- Corrected issue where the list of Send To program names was not being updating on the thumbnails menu when the list of programs was changed until program was restarted.

## **Known Issues**

## **Program Limitations**

- Only one camera can be connected and in use by the program on a single computer.
- Hot switching between camera models (i.e, Changing cameras while the program is running) is not allowed.
- Program cannot be installed onto a network share - can only be installed on a local disk drive.
- Images captured that are not focused in contrast mode live view (i.e., focus indicator not green) will incorrectly display the last phase detect focus point instead of displaying no focus point. The focus points are also incorrectly shown in Nikon Software as they are incorrectly stored in the image by the camera. The degree of this error varies depending on camera model.
- If there are a large number of images (100's) on the memory card installed in the camera it can take several minutes for the program to initialize.
