¹ When installed on Windows Compatibility Mode must be set to Windows Vista Service Pack 2 when installed on a Windows 7 or later.

Enhancements

- Enhanced subfolder logic so that dynamic file names can be created using the date/time and camera model - See [Saving Images](#) in the help file for more information.
- File naming now allows prefixing of the file name from the camera - See [Saving Images](#) in the help file for more details.
- Shows the interval time remaining on the initial interval for start/stop, time length, and number of shot intervals. Weekly schedules will show "WAITING".
- Added option to specify the location of cached images - see [Appending I](#) in the help file for details.
- Changed the maximum shots for Interval Shot Count from 100 to 9999.

- Added a "Show Me How" topic for bracketing with intervals.
- Improved thumbnail display performance on Mac.

Bugs Fixed

RELEASE 1.1.15

- Program crashes when "Lock Camera" set with D600/D610.
- Single shot bracketing & setting of shot count not working correctly.
- Single Shot Bracketing not working with intervals.
- Thumbnails not displayed on some systems.
- Intermittent crashes on some systems after image capture.
- Cameras without Internal Bracketing crashing on Mac.
- Displaying exception errors when displaying properties on Mac.

RELEASE 1.1.16

- Program crashing when deleting multiple images.
- Program crash at startup on systems where program not previously installed.

RELEASE 1.1.18

- Crash with "Unable to Download Image" when capturing RAW + JPG with D40, D40X, D60, D80, D200.
- Thumbnails always show selected when capturing.
- Image Viewer not rotating image.

RELEASE 1.1.20

- Auto displaying virtual keyboard on some versions of Windows.

Known Issues

- Mac OSX 10.11 (El Capitan) is not supported- see [News Item](#) for more details.
- Nikon D5500, D7200, and D810A are not currently supported on Mac.
- Program does not change to the Standard Interface Style when selected - program must be stopped and restarted after setting the Standard Style for it to take effect.
- Images captured that are not focused in contrast mode live view (i.e., focus indicator not green) will incorrectly display the last phase detect focus point instead of displaying no focus point. The focus points are also incorrectly shown in Nikon Software as they are incorrectly stored in the image by the camera. The degree of this error varies depending on camera model.
- If there are a large number of images (100's) on the memory card installed in the camera it can take several minutes for the program to initialize.

Program Limitations

- Only one camera can be connected and in use by the program on a single computer.
- Hot switching between camera models (i.e, Changing cameras while the program is running) is not allowed.
- Program cannot be installed onto a network share - can only be installed on a local disk drive.

- 50 Mbyte free disk space
- Recommended screen resolution 1024 X 768 - lower resolutions supported with scaling.
